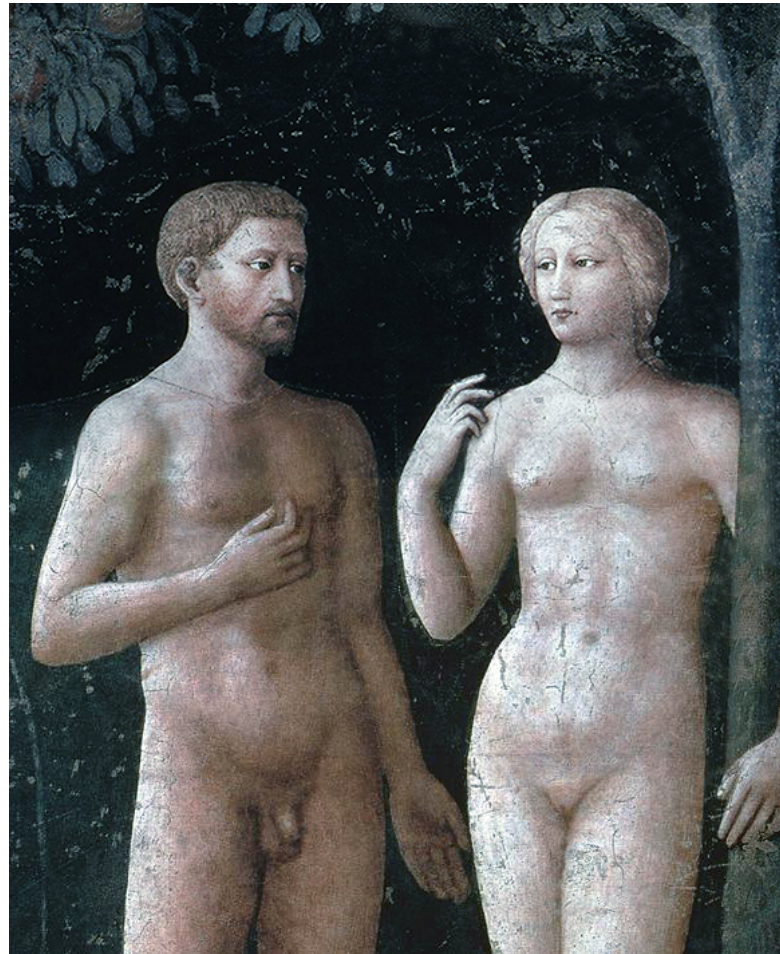

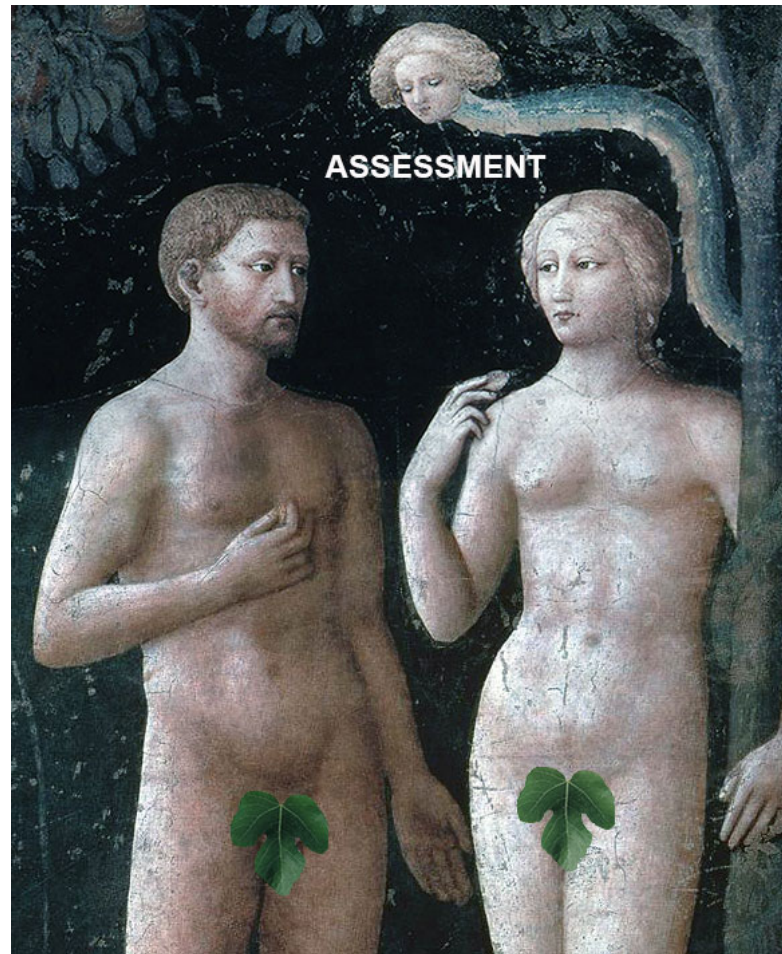

assess (verb)

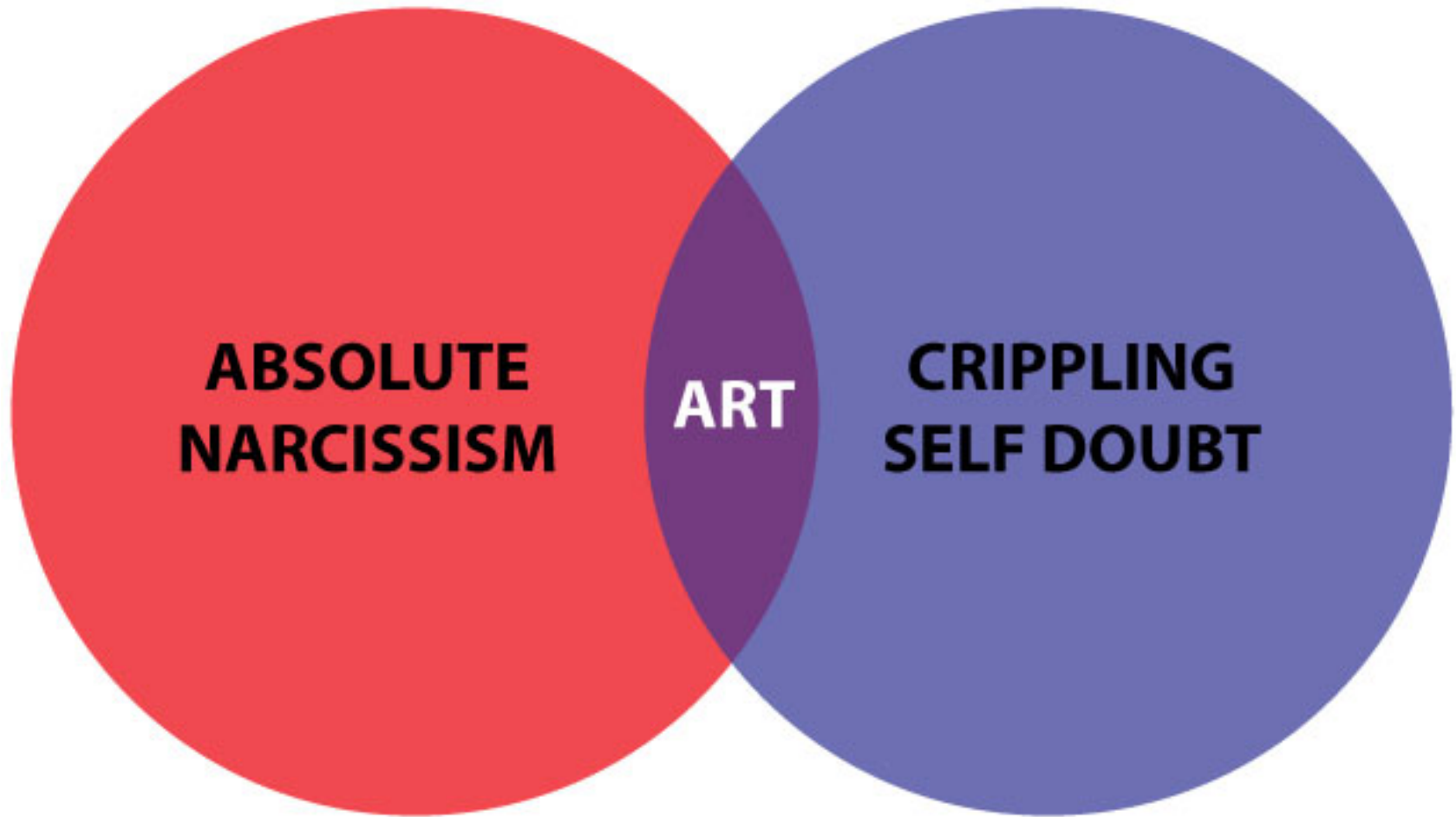
to determine or set the value or amount of; appraise

we develop the model for critique

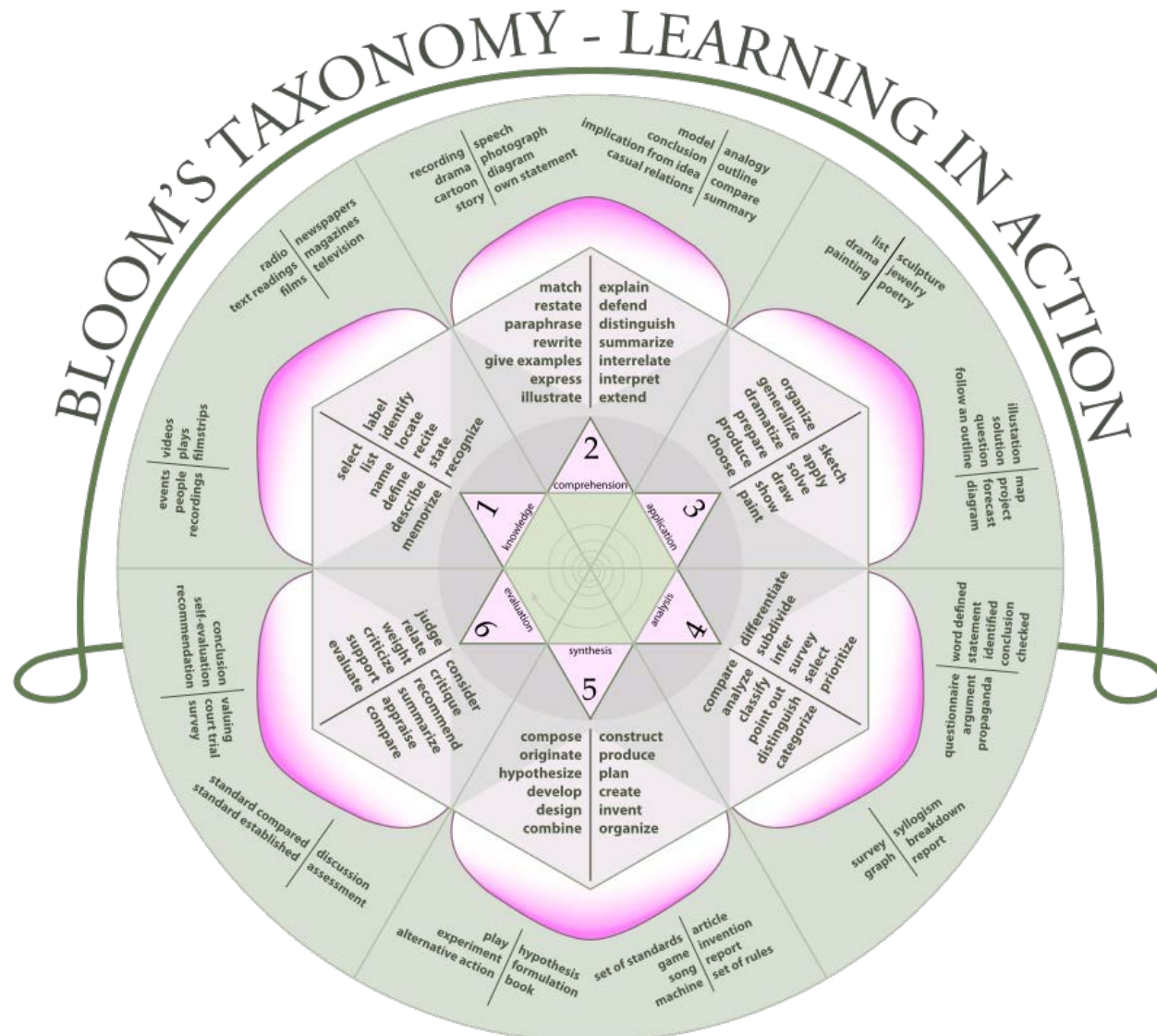
